**Week 14 Report**

**General Legislative Update**

Floor debate seemed to have hit a normal stride for this time of the session and the Senators covered many bills. While progress was made on the floor, the news of the week came when the Revenue Committee announced its tax package which they will advance for full debate. The main points of their tax plan:

- Increase in state sales tax by ½ cent;
- Eliminate tax exemptions on pop and candy;
- Increase tax on cigarettes by 35 cents per pack;
- Earmark the estimated \$51 million in new out-of-state internet sales for future tax relief;
- Utilize most of the \$224 million budgeted for the state property tax credit; and
- Reduce ag land valuations from 75% to 65%. Residential would be reduced from 100% to 90%

This week's State Chamber Meeting featured Governor Ricketts. This meeting occurred before the Revenue Committee released its recommendations. Governor Ricketts gave a brief summary of his priorities as it relates to taxes. A 23% increase into the Property Tax Relief Fund continues to be his main goal. Coming as no surprise, he vowed to veto any tax increase. Even more recently, the Governor has been in the media using the talking points that the timing of increasing taxes on home repairs and bottled water is terrible timing as Nebraskans recover from the floods.

The majority of the Governor's discussion was an update on the flooding. He believes that the local volunteers and first responders should be given credit that it wasn't worse, particularly loss of life. To illustrate the extent of the damage caused by the blizzard/flood, as well as the great progress of the recovery efforts, the Governor pointed out that one-third of the state's roads and highways were closed after the event. Today, only 32 miles of roads remain closed.
